



## Guest Policy

### Policy on Guests

Guests are defined as individuals not affiliated with a member institution and not registered as exhibitors.

- Past officers of the ABFSE, for attendance purposes, are considered members of the ABFSE.
- The Executive Board of the ABFSE may permit attendance of individuals who have a recognized history of service with the ABFSE or member institutions as guests and waive the cost of guest attendance.

Guests are permitted to attend the annual meeting, professional development sessions (for informational purposes, no CEUs), and exhibits/trade show.

**Committee attendance:** Guest attendance at committees.

Attendance at committee meetings (other than the Scholarship or Committee on Accreditation) of the ABFSE shall be open to:

- Members of the committee.
- Members of the ABFSE.
- Members of institutions who have a bona fide academic or business interest in the work of the committee.
  - Anyone attending a committee meeting, who is not a member of the committee, may be asked to leave at the discretion of the chair of the committee.
