

2013 Annual Report Data Summary

58 accredited programs in **32** states

13 states have more than 1 program

[**16** states w/ no program & none currently under serious consideration]

6006 students enrolled in FS Ed in US

1.69% increase over 2012

30 programs had a decline in enrollment

2755 new enrollees

2.2% had previously attended another school/program

1548 grads (for 57 programs = average of 27 grads / program)

Drop-out/attrition rate reported as 2.8%

What else do we know about grads in 2013?

56% of grads were between ages 21-30

1.5% >55

56% grads were females (v. 61% of new enrollees were female)

76% Caucasian

17% were related to someone in the funeral business

for 11% of the grads that relationship was reported as Parent

about 1% - spouse

32% cited the relationship as aunts/uncles/cousins/grandparents/in-laws

63% had 2 or more years of college prior to FS

19% started their FS ed out of HS

18.6% of our grads did their programs on-line

12 programs offer on-line degrees (21%)

12 programs offer from 1-6 on-line courses

NBE

94% of NBE takers in 2013 graduated in 2013

(stated another way, 6% (106 students) of 2013 NBE takers did not graduate in 2013)
